While on routine patrol in the area of Putnam Street and Babcock Street I was approached by one of the security officers/witness Waldeemer Nieves from the Dominick F. Burns elementary school at approximately 1630 hours.</p> <p>Nieves stated that accused was just assaulted by three hispanic males. ran inside of the school to get away from them. I went to the principle's office where I met with complainant/principle Lourdes Soto, Nieves, and mother/accused Sylvia Mojica. I was unable to communicate with Mojica because of the language barrier. I asked complainant Soto if she could interview Mojica. Soto and translated for me. According to Mojica her son has been getting harassed and threatened on a daily basis for at least two weeks. She claims that she has made several complaints to the faculty at the school and has attempted to contact Soto.</p>

DETAILS

Today before her son left for school she encouraged him to bring a BB gun and a pocket knife for protection and she placed them in his backpack. stated students get dismissed between the hours of 1500 and 1530. After went to his locker and gathered his belongings he proceeded to walk out of the doors on the north side of the building and down the steps. He walked down an embankment and saw a group of Hispanic males approximately twenty five feet away from him. When he made eye contact with them they ran towards him. saw suspect " " with a knife in his hand. ran back up the embankment and into the principal's office. While attempting to run away he hurt his leg. I spoke to Nieves who stated he observed the suspects run after Nieves stated that he attempted to detain suspect " but was pushed by suspect " " causing him to stumble backwards. Suspect " " then ran away with the rest of the suspects. The group of suspects were last seen running north on Putnam Street and turned east onto Russ Street. Nieves reported the suspects were not students at Burns School, but he knew them from the neighborhood and knows them by name but did not know any other facts concerning thier identities. Nieves reported he did not see any of the suspects with a knife. stated that he believed the suspects lived on Lawrence Street in a housing complex known as Casanueva. I canvassed the area for the suspects. I was able to get inside of the building at 186 Lawrence Street. I asked a few of the tenants if they were familiar with any of the suspects. They were unable to provide me with any information. The doors on the rest of the buildings were locked. I was unable to locate any of the suspects. admitted that his mother Mojica encouraged him to bring the BB gun and the knife to school. never used the BB gun or knife. Soto asked if he had any weapons with him. then said yes and surrendered a knife and BB gun from his backpack to Principal Soto. The weapons were the turned over to this officer. DCF intake Lynn Fuller was notified of the situation. Mojica was asked if she wanted to have medical attention for his leg, Mojica and refused medical attention.
